Cell Phones & Dagers:

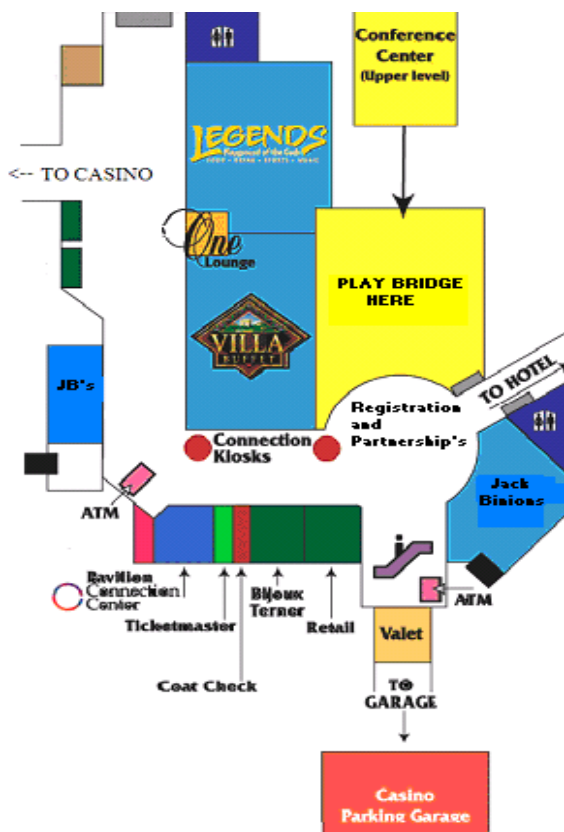
